

ORDINANCE NO. 1468

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (8) of subsection (g) of Section 42-27 of Article V of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article V relates to OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING GENERALLY, which Section 42-27 relates to OFF-STREET PARKING GENERALLY, which subsection (g) relates to SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS, and which subsection (8) relates to THEATRES, AUDITORIUMS, ASSEMBLY HALLS AND RESTAURANTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (8) of subsection (g) of Section 42-27 of Article V of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and re-ordained to read as follows:

(8) Theatres, auditoriums, assembly halls and restaurants--One space for each four seats; except, that for restaurants used to serve the employees, but not the general public, of a multi-story office building of four stories or more in height and located entirely within such building with no direct ingress or egress to the restaurant from the exterior of the building except those required for service and emergency purposes and without any sign identifying such restaurant from the exterior of the restaurant or building, one space for each eight seats, (provided that this exception shall be permitted only with a special use permit as specified in Sections 42-68 to 42-71 of this Code.)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
