

ORDINANCE NO. 1530

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 10-10, Article I, Chapter 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 10 relates to ELECTRICITY, which Article I relates to ELECTRICITY IN GENERAL, and which Section 10-10 relates to WORK TO COMPLY WITH NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 10-10, Article I, Chapter 10 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 10-10. Work to comply with National Electrical Code.

All electrical work shall be done in a manner prescribed by the regulations known as the "National Electrical Code * 1968" published by the National Fire Protection Association, being further identified as "*USA Standard NFPA No. 70-1968, USAS CI-1968" (Revision of CI-1965), together with such supplementary rules and regulations as may be issued from time to time by the electrical board and approved by the city council. Any such supplementary regulations shall be effective thirty days after they are approved by the council, and copies thereof shall be furnished all registered electricians by the electrical inspector. Said National Electrical Code 1968 is hereby adopted and incorporated herein as fully as if set out at length.

One copy of said National Electrical Code 1968, to be known as the Official Copy, shall be manually signed on its cover by the Mayor and the Electrical Inspector and filed in the office of the Electrical Inspector in the City Hall, City of Alexandria, Virginia, for reference and safekeeping.

At least five (5) copies of said National Electrical Code 1968 shall be placed in the office of the Electrical Inspector in the City Hall, Alexandria, Virginia, where they may be viewed, examined and obtained between the hours of 9:00 A. M. and 5:00 P.M. Monday through Friday inclusive of each week, except for holidays.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1969.
