

AN ORDINANCE to vacate a portion of one alley and all of another alley located in the southeasterly portion of the block bounded by Gibbon, South Royal, Wilkes and South Pitt Streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law, including the posting of notices and of notice to the land proprietors affected, have been followed; and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia and have made their report; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the report of said viewers recommending the said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia that the one alley and portion of another located within the southeasterly portion of the block bounded by Gibbon, South Royal, Wilkes and South Pitt Streets, the alleys hereinabove mentioned and hereinafter described are not needed for public use and that it is in the public interest to vacate the said alleys; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described alley and portion of another alley situated within the southeasterly portion of the block bounded by Gibbon, South Royal, Wilkes and South Pitt Streets, located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby are vacated, abandoned and discontinued:

That alley shown on a plat appended to a deed recorded among the land records of the City of Alexandria, Virginia in Deed Book 3 at pages 332 and 333, which alley appears on said plat as being 10 feet in width and running from South Royal Street in a westerly direction, between the southerly lines of lots 33 and 48 and the northerly lines of lots 1 through 8, inclusive, to the easterly line of a 20 foot wide alley.

That portion of an alley, shown on the above-mentioned plat, which portion appears on said plat as being 5.5 feet in width, and running from the notherly line of the above vacated alley in a northerly direction for 52 feet, between the westerly lines of lots 45, 46, 47, 48 and the easterly lines of lots 33, 34, 35 and 36.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days

following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
