

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (a), Section 42-69, Article X, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article X relates to SPECIAL USE PERMITS, which Section 42-69 relates to PROCEDURE AS TO ISSUANCE and which subsection (a) relates to WRITTEN APPLICATION AND FEE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a), Section 42-69, Article X, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(a) Written application for a use permit shall be transmitted to the city manager together with a * fee of fifty dollars. *

Section 2. That in the opinion of the city council an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE in order to immediately bring the fee for a special use permit in line with the costs of processing.

Section 3. That this emergency ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
