

ORDINANCE NO. 1573

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the last sentence of the first paragraph of Section 42-102, Article XV, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article XV relates to AMENDMENTS, etc., which Section 42-102 relates to APPLICATIONS FOR AMENDMENT, etc., GENERALLY, which first paragraph relates to NATURE OF APPLICATION and which last sentence relates to FILING COSTS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to due and timely notice of the time and place of hearing published in a daily paper of general circulation published in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, a public hearing was held in relation to the matters hereinafter set forth, at which public hearing parties in interest and citizens had an opportunity to be heard.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the last sentence of the first paragraph of Section 42-102, Article XV, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Each such application shall be accompanied by a check or money order for * the sum of one hundred dollars for the first half acre or portion thereof, plus twenty dollars for each additional half acre of land or portion thereof involved.

Section 2. That in the opinion of the city council an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE in order to immediately bring the fee for an application for change in zone classification in line with the costs of processing.

Section 3. That this emergency ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
