

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 42-68, Article X, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article X relates to SPECIAL USE PERMITS, and which Section 42-68 relates to INTENT OF ARTICLE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 42-68, Article X, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 42-68. Intent of article.

It is the intent of this article to provide for review by the council of the use of land for certain purposes which normally would be allowed in the zones as set forth in sections 42-5 to 42-22.2 of this Code, but which, due to peculiar conditions connected with such uses, may warrant further investigation and review.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
