

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 37-70, Division 4 Article I, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 37 relates to TAXICABS, ETC., FOR HIRE, which Article I relates to TAXICABS AND FOR-HIRE VEHICLES, which Division 4 relates to EQUIPMENT, MAINTENANCE AND USE OF VEHICLES and which Section 37-70 relates to CLEANLINESS AND APPEARANCE OF DRIVERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 37-70, Division 4, Article I, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963 as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 37-70. Cleanliness and appearance of drivers.

Drivers of vehicles operated pursuant to this article shall be clean * and dressed in neat clean clothing at all times when serving the public. Whenever a driver's appearance is significantly changed by haircut or hair style, or modification, addition, or removal of a beard, moustache, side burns, toupee, wig, hair coloring, or the like, he shall submit within thirty (30) days of such change, a new photograph of himself in compliance with the requirements of section 37-22 of this Code.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
