

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to repeal Article XII of Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, which Chapter 36 relates to TAXATION, and which Article XII relates to and imposes ADMISSION TAXES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article XII of Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That in the opinion of Council an emergency exists and this is declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE in order to prevent hardship to businesses, charities, schools and other persons and organizations within the City.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall not be published in a newspaper. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This Ordinance shall become effective October 1, 1969, and the admission tax heretofore levied and imposed shall not apply to any event taking place on or after October 1, 1969.
