

ORDINANCE NO. 1626

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend Section 30-6 of Chapter 30 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new subsection lettered (g); which Chapter 30 relates to SITE PLANS; which Section 30-6 relates to EXCEPTIONS AS TO CERTAIN DWELLINGS, ETC; and which new subsection (g) relates to TRACT OR TRACT OF LAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That section 30-6 of Chapter 30 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection (g), to read as follows:

(g) Tract or tract of land to be developed or built upon pursuant to the requirements of Section 42-19(h), Planned residential and/or commercial developments, of this code.

Section II. That in the opinion of the City Council an emergency exists and this ordinance is hereby declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to prevent several months delay in enacting it into law. This ordinance is deemed important to the City of Alexandria and should be enacted so that builders and developers can plan accordingly.

Section III. That this EMERGENCY ORDINANCE shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
