

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the first paragraph of Section 30-21 of Chapter 30 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 30 relates to SITE PLANS, which Section 30-21 relates to AS BUILT SITE PLANS and which first paragraph relates to REQUIREMENT OF AS BUILT SITE PLAN BEFORE USE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the first paragraph of Section 30-21 of Chapter 30 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any person to occupy or cause or allow to be occupied, any building, structure or portion thereof or use, or cause or allow to be used any land for which a site plan is required by this chapter until an "as built site plan" has been approved by the director \*.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
