

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 22-59, Division 1, Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article III relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES, which Division 1 relates to IN GENERAL and which Section 22-59 relates to DRIVING WITHOUT LICENSE PROHIBITED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-59, Division 1, Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-59. Driving without license prohibited.

(a) No person, except those expressly exempted by article II, chapter 5, title 46.1, of the Code of Virginia, as amended, shall drive any motor vehicle upon any street or highway in the city until such person shall have made application for an operator's or chauffeur's license as provided by article IV, chapter 5, title 46.1 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, and shall have satisfactorily passed the examination required by section 46.1-369 of the Code of Virginia, as amended, and obtained either an operator's or chauffeur's license, * which is valid at the time of said driving.

(b) Upon a first conviction of a violation of this section, the penalty imposed shall be as provided in section 13-1 of this Code. Upon a second or subsequent conviction of a violation of this section, which second offense shall have occurred within one year of a first offense, the penalty shall be imprisonment in jail for not less than ten days nor more than six months, and, in addition, may be a fine not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective June 26, 1970.
