

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 22-69.2, Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article III relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES, which Division 2 relates to RECKLESS DRIVING, SPEEDING, ETC.; and which Section 22-69.2 relates to SWORN REPORT OF RESULTS OF CALIBRATION TEST ADMISSIBLE IN EVIDENCE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA. HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-69.2, Division 2, Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 22-69.2. Sworn report of results of calibration test admissible in evidence.

In the trial of any person charged with exceeding any maximum speed limit in this city, the court * shall receive as evidence a sworn report of the results of a calibration test of the accuracy of the speedometer in the motor vehicle operated by the defendant or the arresting officer at the time of the alleged offense.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective June 26, 1970.
