

AN ORDINANCE to amend Division 1, Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-63.1; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article III relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES, which Division 1 relates to IN GENERAL, and which new section numbered 22-63.1 relates to OCCUPATION OF CERTAIN TRAILERS WHILE BEING TOWED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Division 1 of Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-63.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 22-63.1. Occupation of Certain Trailers While Being Towed.

Any person who occupies a house trailer or camping trailer while such trailer is being towed upon a public highway in this city, or any operator of a towing vehicle who knowingly permits another person to do such, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective June 26, 1970.
