

ORDINANCE NO. 1649

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 22-176, Article VII, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article VII relates to LIGHTING EQUIPMENT, and which Section 22-176 relates to WHEN LIGHTS TO BE LIGHTED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-176, Article VII, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-176. When lights to be lighted.

Every vehicle upon a street within the city shall display lighted head lamps and illuminating devices as required by this chapter from a half hour after sunset to a half hour before sunrise and at any other time when due to insufficient light or unfavorable atmospheric conditions, persons in vehicles on the highway are not clearly discernible at a distance of five hundred feet.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective June 26, 1970.
