

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (c) of Section 22-188, Article VIII, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article VIII relates to BRAKES, HORNS AND OTHER MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT, which Section 22-188 relates to BRAKES--TRAILERS, and which subsection (c) thereof relates to WHICH VEHICLES SECTION DOES NOT APPLY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (c) of Section 22-188, Article VIII, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(c) This section shall not apply to any vehicle being towed for repairs, repossession, or in a bona fide emergency, or being moved by a wrecker when two wheels of the towed vehicle are off the ground.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective June 26, 1970.
