

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to amend Article VIII, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 2-101.2; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article VIII relates to PERSONNEL and which new Section 2-101.2 relates to RETIREMENT PLAN--CITY SUPPLEMENTAL.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article VIII, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is ~~amended~~ amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 2-101.2 to read as follows:

Sec. 2-101.2. Retirement plan--city supplemental.

The City of Alexandria, Virginia Supplemental Retirement Plan, entitled "CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA GROUP CONTRACT NO. GA 8738", dated August 1, 1970 and underwritten by Bankers Life Company, is hereby adopted for the eligible employees of the city other than policemen and firemen. This plan shall be in addition to any other retirement plan now or hereafter adopted. The plan shall become effective at the earliest practicable date and the city manager is authorized to sign all contracts and papers for and on behalf of the city in connection with such plan.

Employees on the payroll of the city on the effective date of the plan shall have their choice as to whether or not they wish to participate in the plan. Persons employed by the city after the effective date of the plan shall be required to join in and participate in the plan.

The director of finance is hereby authorized to deduct and withhold employees' contributions, either voluntary or mandatory, for the plan. The director of finance is further authorized to expend the share of the city toward maintaining the plan.

The director of personnel, under the city manager, shall administer the plan. Any action with respect to the plan taken prior to the passage of this section is hereby ratified, approved and confirmed.

Section 2. That in the opinion of council an emergency exists and this is declared an EMERGENCY ORDINANCE. The reasons for the emergency are as follows: The plan concept has in fact been approved, and money budgeted and appropriated therefor; steps preliminary to the implementation of the plan have been taken; and city employees need a supplemental retirement plan as soon as possible.

Section 3. That this emergency ordinance shall not be published. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction

and first reading, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the moment of its final passage.
