

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 7-8, Chapter 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by amending and reordaining subsection (224) thereof; which Chapter 7 constitutes THE BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, VIRGINIA, which Section 7-8 relates to CHANGES IN BOCA CODE, and which subsection (224) thereof relates to MINIMUM THICKNESS OF METAL.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (224) of Section 7-8, Chapter 7 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(224) Section 828.2 is amended to read:

828.2. Minimum Thickness of Metal. - The minimum permissible thickness of metal for formed steel structural members shall be based on the use of the members as follows:

Siding and sheathing.....	No.28 U.S. Gage
Ribbed steel roof construction.....	<u>No.22 U.S. Gage</u>
Steel floor plates.....	No.16 U.S. Gage
Studs, joists, purlins, structural rib, horizontal girts.....	No.16 U.S. Gage
Furring members.....	No.18 U.S. Gage

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
