

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 23-9, Chapter 23 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, \* as amended; which Chapter 23 relates to OFFENSES--MISCELLANEOUS, and which Section 23-9 relates to DANCING--IN ESTABLISHMENTS SERVING BEER, WINE, AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 23-9 of Chapter 23 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 23-9. Dancing--In establishments serving beer, wine, and alcoholic beverages.

Dancing is prohibited in any establishment within the city \* in which beer, wine \* or alcoholic beverages are sold or consumed upon the premises, except as follows:

(a) a hotel holding valid city and state hotel business licenses;

(b) any place not open to public patronage or admission;

(c) any establishment operated by a person holding a valid, unrevoked, unsuspended mixed beverage restaurant license for that establishment granted by the Virginia Alcoholic Beverage Control Board or its successor.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
