

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (37), Section 42-1, Article I, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article I relates to DEFINITIONS, which Section 42-1 relates to ENUMERATION OF DEFINITIONS, and which subsection (37) thereof relates to the definition of HOSPITAL.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (37), Section 42-1, Article I, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(37) Hospital. A building or group of buildings designed, used or intended to be used for inpatient and/or outpatient medical care of * all types, * including the care of mental, drug-addiction or alcoholic cases. This terminology shall include, but not be limited to sanitariums, nursing homes and convalescent homes.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
