

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsections (c) and (e) of Section 33-69, Article V, Chapter 33 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 33 relates to STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, which Article V relates to EXCAVATIONS, which Section 33-69 relates to BACKFILL, which subsection (c) thereof relates to BACKFILL MATERIAL and which subsection (e) thereof relates to BACKFILLING IN STREET AND ALLEY RIGHTS OF WAY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsections (c) and (e) of Section 33-69, Article V, Chapter 33 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby are amended and reordained to read as follows:

(c) Backfill material. Backfill material used in excavation shall be of granular material and conform to sections 206 * or 208 type I or type II or 209 or 210 or a combination thereof of the Virginia Department of Highways Road and Bridge Specifications, July 1, 1970 except when, in the opinion of the director of public works or his authorized representative, material excavated from the trench is satisfactory for such use.

(e) Backfilling in street and alley rights of way. The placing of backfill within the limits of the right of way of any street or alley shall be done in conformance with section * 303.10 under the Virginia Department of Highways Road and Bridge Specifications, July 1, 1970.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
