

ORDINANCE NO. 1734

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 20-91 of Article IV of Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 20 relates to LICENSES, which Article IV relates to MOTOR VEHICLES, TRUCKS AND TRAILERS; UTILITY TRAILERS; MOTORCYCLES, and which Section 20-91 relates to PASSENGER VEHICLES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 20-91 of Article IV of Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 20-91. Passenger vehicles.

On all vehicles designed for the transportation of passengers, and operated on the streets of the city, which vehicles are either (1) registered and licensed by the Virginia Division of Motor Vehicles, the registration for each of which shows an address in the city, or (2) registered and licensed by the Virginia Division of Motor Vehicles, the registration for each of which shows an address elsewhere in Virginia, and which have been in the city for a period of at least thirty days, or (3) registered and licensed by another state and which have been in the city for a period of at least thirty days, or (4) used in the conduct of any business or occupation within the city, there shall be an annual license tax for each vehicle in the amount of ten dollars. Each such vehicle shall be provided with an approved city license windshield tag which shall be affixed on the inside of the windshield of the vehicle. It shall be placed adjacent to the state inspection sticker and not more than three inches from the bottom of the windshield.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
