

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 42-1 of Article I of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (2)a, and to amend and reordain subsection (10) of subsection (a) of Section 42-6 of Article III of Chapter 42 of said Code; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article I relates to DEFINITIONS, which Section 42-1 relates to ENUMERATION OF DEFINITIONS and which new subsection (2)a relates to ACCESSORY USE; which Article III relates to USE, AREA, ETC., REGULATIONS GENERALLY, which Section 42-6 relates to R-20 RESIDENCE ZONE, which subsection (a) relates to USES PERMITTED, and which subsection (10) relates to ACCESSORY BUILDINGS AND USES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 42-1 of Article I of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (2)a to read as follows:

(2)a. Accessory use. A use which is subordinate and incidental to a permitted use and which is intended for the exclusive use of the occupants of the permitted use; provided that any such accessory use is operated and maintained, directly or indirectly, under the same ownership and on the same lot as the permitted use.

Section 2. That subsection (10) of subsection (a) of Section 42-6, Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(10) Accessory buildings and accessory uses, including private garages, private stables, and servants' quarters, as provided in Sections 42-23 to 42-25 of this Code.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
