

ORDINANCE NO. 1775

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 22-123 and Section 22-124, Division 1, Article V of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC; which Article V relates to PARKING METERS, which Division 1 relates to ON STREETS, which Section 22-123 relates to PARKING METER ZONES ESTABLISHED, and which Section 22-124 relates to TIME LIMITS; WHEN METERS TO BE IN OPERATION; COINS DEPOSITED. .

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-123, Division 1, Article V of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-123. Parking meter zones established.

The following described parts of the streets of the city are hereby established as parking meter zones:

(a) Both sides of the 200 block, 800 block, 1200 block and 1500 block of King Street; south side of the 400 block, 500 block, 1100 block, 1600 block and 1800 block of King Street; and the north side of the 900, 1300 and 1400 blocks of King Street.

(b) Both sides of the 100 block north and the 100 block south of Pitt Street, Columbus Street, Alfred Street, Fayette Street, Payne Street and West Street.

(c) Both sides of the 200 and 300 blocks of North Washington Street and the 200 and 300 blocks of South Washington Street; west side of the 100 block of South Washington Street; and east side of the 100 block of North Washington Street.

(d) Both sides of Cameron Street between Fairfax Street and Washington Street and both sides of Cameron Street between Columbus Street and Alfred Street.

(e) Both sides of Prince Street between Royal Street and Columbus Street.

(f) Both sides of the 200 block of South Columbus Street.

(g) Both sides of the 700 block of Duke Street.

(h) North side of the 700 block of Queen Street.

(i) Both sides of the 100 block of South St. Asaph Street and both sides of the 100 block of North St. Asaph Street.

(j) Both sides of the 100 block of South Royal Street.

(k) Both sides of the 100 block of South Fairfax Street and the east side of the 100 block of North Fairfax Street.

(l) West side of the 100 block of North Henry Street and the 100 block of South Henry Street.

(m) East Side of the 100 block of North Patrick Street and the 100 block of South Patrick Street.

The number and locations of parking meters in the above created zones shall be determined by resolution of the City Council.

Section 2. That Section 22-124, Division 1, Article V, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-124. Time limits; when meters to be in operation; coins deposited.

The meters in the zones established in section 22-123 of this Code shall be operated every day except Sundays and legal state holidays, the hours of operation to be determined by city council by the passage of appropriate resolutions pertaining thereto.

The time limits for parking in any space in such parking meter zones shall be determined by the deposit of a coin in each parking meter as follows:

- (1) Any period of time up to twenty minutes in those areas limited to twenty minute parking for ten cents, one dime.
- (2) Any period of time up to one hour in those areas limited to one hour parking for ten cents, one dime.
- (3) Any period of time up to one hour in those areas limited to two hour parking, ten cents, one dime for each hour.

The time limits for the meters in those zones established in section 22-123 of this Code shall be determined by resolution of the city council.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
