

ORDINANCE NO. 1789

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the last paragraph of Section 22-175, Article VII of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article VII relates to LIGHTING EQUIPMENT, which Section 22-175 relates to OTHER PERMISSIBLE LIGHTS; POLICE AND FIRE-FIGHTING VEHICLES, EMERGENCY VEHICLES, ETC., and which last paragraph thereof relates to CERTAIN LIGHTING DEVICES PROHIBITED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the last paragraph of Section 22-175, Article VII of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

No motor vehicle shall be operated on any street which is equipped with any lighting device other than lamps required or permitted in this article or required or approved by the superintendent or required by the Federal Department of Transportation.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1972.
