

AN ORDINANCE to amend Division 2 of Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-68.2; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article III relates to OPERATION OF VEHICLES, which Division 2 relates to RECKLESS DRIVING, SPEEDING, ETC., and which new section numbered 22-68.2 relates to SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE TO BE NOTIFIED OF ANY RACE TO BE HELD ON PRIVATE PROPERTY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Division 2 of Article III, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-68.2 to read as follows:

Sec. 22-68.2. Superintendent of police to be notified of any race to be held on private property.

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any driveway or premises of a church, school, recreational facility or business property open to the public in the city, or his agent, to authorize any race to be engaged in upon such property between two or more motor vehicles without first notifying the superintendent of police, in writing, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to such race regarding the time and location of the race to be held. Any violation of this section shall be punished pursuant to section 22-19.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
