

ORDINANCE NO. 1829

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 1-12 and 1-15, subparagraph (3) of subsection (d) and subparagraphs (5) and (6) of subsection (g) of Section 1-17, all of Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Section 1-12 relates to WARD BOUNDARIES--FOURTH WARD, which Section 1-15 relates to SAME--SEVENTH WARD, which subparagraph (3) relates to THE PRINCE STREET SCHOOL ELECTION DISTRICT, which subsection (d) relates to FOURTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN, which subparagraph (5) relates to THE SOUTHPORT GARDENS ELECTION DISTRICT, which subparagraph (6) relates to THE TEMPLE BETH EL ELECTION DISTRICT, which subsection (g) relates to SEVENTH WARD AND ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES THEREIN, which Section 1-17 relates to ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS AND VOTING PLACES, and which Chapter 1 relates to GENERAL PROVISIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 1-12, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1-12. Same--Fourth ward.

The boundaries of the fourth ward shall be as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the center line of King Street with the center line of Washington Street, thence westwardly and northwestwardly with the center line of King Street to the center line of Radford Street, then northward along the center line of Radford Street to the center line of Braddock Road, then westward along the center line of Braddock Road to the center line of King Street, then westward along the center line of King Street to the center line of Quaker Lane, thence southwardly with the center line of Quaker Lane, to the center line of Duke Street; thence east with the center line of Duke Street to the center line of South Quaker Lane, then south with the center line of South Quaker Lane to Cameron Run; then eastwardly with Cameron Run to the center line of South Quaker Lane; then southwardly with the center line of South Quaker Lane to the south corporate limits established as of January 1, 1973; then eastwardly along the south corporate limits to the center line of Washington Street, then northwardly with the center line of Washington Street to the center line of King Street.

Section 2. That Section 1-15, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 1-15. Same--Seventh ward.

The boundary of the seventh ward shall be as follows: Beginning at the intersection of South Quaker Lane with the south corporate limits, as established January 1, 1973, and running thence with such south and west corporate limits in a generally westerly direction to the intersection of such limits with the center line of Shirley Highway; thence northerly along the center line of Shirley Highway to its intersection with the Arlington County line lying just north of the center line of King Street (Leesburg Turnpike); thence easterly along the Arlington County line to its intersection with the center line of North Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the center line of Quaker Lane to its intersection with the center line of Duke Street; thence easterly along such center line of Duke Street to its intersection with the center line of South Quaker Lane; thence southerly along the center line of South Quaker Lane to Cameron Run; thence eastwardly with Cameron Run to the center line of South Quaker Lane; then southwardly with the center line of South Quaker Lane to the point of beginning.

Section 3. That subparagraph (3) of subsection (d), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(3) The Prince Street School Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the center line of the intersection of Wilkes Street and South Washington Street; thence northward along the center line of South Washington Street to the center line of King Street; thence westward along the center line of King Street to the western right-of-way line of the Richmond, Fredericksburg, and Potomac Railroad; thence westward along such right-of-way line to the center line of South Quaker Lane; thence southward along the center line of South Quaker Lane to Cameron Run; then eastwardly with Cameron Run to the center line of South Quaker Lane; then southwardly with the center line of South Quaker Lane to the southern city boundary as established January 1, 1973; thence eastward along such boundary to the center line of Hooffs Run; thence northward along the center line of Hooffs Run to a point where it would intersect with a western protraction of the center line of Wilkes Street; thence eastward in a straight line to the center line of Wilkes Street; thence eastward along the center line of Wilkes Street to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Prince Street School Election District shall be at the Prince Street School, located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Patrick Street and Prince Street.

Section 4. That subparagraphs (5) and (6) of subsection (g), Section 1-17, Chapter 1 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby are amended and reordained to read as follows:

(5) The Southport Gardens Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the north boundary of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad right of way and the center line of Cameron Run; thence along a line bearing due south to the southern city boundary as established January 1, 1973; thence westward along the southern city boundary and northward along the western city boundary to the center line of Henry G. Shirley Memorial Highway; thence northward along the center line of such highway to the center line of Duke Street; thence eastward along the center line of Duke Street to the center line of South Jordan Street; thence southward along the center line of South Jordan Street to the center line of Holmes Run; thence southward along the center line of Holmes Run to the center line of Cameron Run; thence southward along the center line of Cameron Run to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Southport Gardens Election District shall be at the Southport Gardens Apartments, 6112 Edsall Road.

(6) The Temple Beth El Election District shall be bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of South Quaker Lane and the southern boundary of the city as established January 1, 1973; thence northward along the center line of South Quaker Lane to the center line of Cameron Run; thence westwardly with the center line of Cameron Run to the center line of South Quaker Lane; thence northward along the center line of South Quaker Lane to the center line of Duke Street; thence westward along the center line of Duke Street to the center line of North Quaker Lane; thence northward along the center line of North Quaker Lane to the center line of Seminary Road; thence westward along the center line of Seminary Road to the center line of North Jordan Street; thence southward along the center line of North and South Jordan Streets to the center line of Holmes Run; thence southward along the center line of Holmes Run to the center line of Cameron Run; thence southward along the center line of Cameron Run to the north boundary of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad right of way; then along a line bearing due south to the southern boundary of the city; thence eastward along the southern boundary of the city to the point of beginning.

The voting place within the Temple Beth El Election District shall be Temple Beth El, 3830 Seminary Road.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later ~~than~~ five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
