

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (4), subsection (a), Section 42-64, Article IX, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article IX relates to SIGNS, which Section 42-64 relates to COMMERCIAL ZONES, which subsection (a) relates to SIGNS IN COMMERCIAL ZONES and which subsection (4) relates to BANNERS ACROSS PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (4) of subsection (a) of Section 42-64, Article IX, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(4) Banners across streets, highways, alleys, sidewalks or other public rights of way (permitted only for special occasions with approval of city council.)

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
