

ORDINANCE NO. 1846

AN ORDINANCE to amend Article IX of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 42-67.1; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article IX relates to SIGNS, and which new Section 42-67.1 relates to POLITICAL SIGNS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article IX of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 42-67.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 42-67.1. Political signs.

Political signs, other than banners, may be erected in all zones, provided they are on the public streets or on the exterior of public places and are in compliance with section 29-2.1 of this code.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
