

AN ORDINANCE to vacate that part of South Fayette Street located between Wilkes and Wolfe Streets in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, said vacation has been approved by the Planning Commission at one of its regular meetings; and

WHEREAS, the procedures required by law, including the posting of notice to the land proprietors affected, have been followed; and

WHEREAS, viewers were duly appointed by the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and have made their report; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the report of the said viewers recommending the said vacation, and of other evidence relative thereto, it is the opinion of the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia that the portion of South Fayette Street hereinabove mentioned and hereinafter described is not needed for public use and that it is in the public interest to vacate the said portion of South Fayette Street; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the part of South Fayette Street between Wilkes and Wolfe Streets, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and which is more particularly described as follows, be and the same hereby is vacated and abandoned:

Beginning at a point marking the intersection of the northerly line of Wilkes Street and the westerly line of South Fayette Street and running thence with the said westerly line of South Fayette Street North 09° 30' East 353.17 feet to a point marking the intersection of the said line of South Fayette Street and the southerly line of Wolfe Street; thence crossing South Fayette Street in line with the said southerly line of Wolfe Street South 80° 41' East 66.08 feet to a point marking the intersection of the said line of Wolfe Street and the easterly line of South Fayette Street; thence running with the said easterly line of South Fayette Street South 09° 30' West 353.17 feet to a point marking the intersection of the said line of South Fayette Street and the northerly line of Wilkes Street; and thence crossing South Fayette Street in line with the said northerly line of Wilkes Street North 80° 41' West 66.08 feet to the point of beginning, containing 23,337 square feet.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later

than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
