

ORDINANCE NO. 1857

AN ORDINANCE to amend Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-105.1; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article IV relates to STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING GENERALLY, which Division 1 relates to IN GENERAL, and which new Section 22-105.1 relates to PARKING OF VEHICLES BY BUSINESSES ON STREETS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Division 1, Article IV of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-105.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 22-105.1. Parking of vehicles by businesses on streets.

No person, who operates a business which services, repairs, stores or parks vehicles of other persons, shall park or cause to be parked any such vehicle upon any street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The Clerk of the Council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
