

AN ORDINANCE to repeal ordinances numbered 1376, 1387 and 1443 of the City of Alexandria, Virginia; which Ordinance No. 1376 was adopted March 22, 1966 and made effective March 22, 1966; which Ordinance No. 1387 was adopted June 14, 1966 and made effective June 14, 1966; which Ordinance No. 1443 was adopted June 27, 1967 and made effective June 27, 1967; and which ordinances created a City of Alexandria, Virginia ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITIES COMMISSION and provided for an Economic Opportunities Coordinator, and prescribed their powers and duties.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia is advised that Federal aid will no longer be available to support the activities of the City Economic Opportunities Commission; and

WHEREAS, ordinances numbered 1376, 1387 and 1443 were drafted primarily so that they would work with Federal aid and within the framework of Federal law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is of the opinion that ordinances numbered 1376, 1387 and 1443 no longer constitute a suitable law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council intends to adopt a suitable new law which would establish a new City Economic Opportunities Commission, provide for a coordinator and prescribe their powers and duties; therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That City of Alexandria, Virginia Ordinance No. 1376, adopted March 22, 1966 and made effective March 22, 1966, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That City of Alexandria, Virginia Ordinance No. 1387, adopted June 14, 1966 and made effective June 14, 1966, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. That City of Alexandria, Virginia Ordinance No. 1443, adopted June 27, 1967 and made effective June 27, 1967, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective September 1, 1973.
