

ORDINANCE NO. 1884

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the second paragraph of Section 42-103, Article XV, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article XV relates to AMENDMENTS, ETC., which Section 42-103 relates to RECOMMENDATION OF PLANNING COMMISSION; ACTION BY COUNCIL; REFERENCE TO PLANNING COMMISSION FOR FURTHER STUDY, and which second paragraph relates to ACTION REQUIRED BY COUNCIL.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the second paragraph of Section 42-103, Article XV, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

In any event, at this point, or not later than at the next regular meeting, the city council shall either approve such application, reject such application or refer it to the planning commission; provided, that if such application is rejected, it may also be referred to the commission for further study. If a referral is made, the city council may include such suggestions and modifications as it shall see fit.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The clerk of the council shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
