

ORDINANCE NO. 1951

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Sections 29A-1, 29A-3, and subsection (a) of Section 29A-5, Chapter 29A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 29A relates to SISTER CITY, which Section 29A-1 relates to and ESTABLISHES A SISTER CITY, which Section 29A-3 relates to MEMBERSHIP OF SISTER CITY COMMITTEE, which Section 29A-5 relates to POWERS AND DUTIES OF COMMITTEE and which subsection (a) thereof relates to PROMOTION OF EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL EXCHANGE OF SISTER CITIES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 29A-1, Chapter 29A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 29A-1. Established.

The City of Dundee, Scotland, is adopted and established as a sister city to Alexandria.

Section 2. That Section 29A-3, Chapter 29A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 29A-3. Same--Membership; appointment; compensation.

The committee shall consist of at least eleven members to be appointed by the city council from the organizations and citizenry listed below. The members shall serve without compensation and at the will of the council.

Alexandria city council, 1 member
Alexandria public school board, 1 member
Alexandria Tourist Council, 1 member
Citizens, 8 members

Section 3. That subsection (a), Section 29A-5, Chapter 29A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(a) Plan, develop, encourage and promote an educational and cultural exchange between the City of Dundee, Scotland and Alexandria.

Section 4. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading, and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
