

AN ORDINANCE appropriating and allotting the proceeds of the sale of \$13,820,000 City of Alexandria, Virginia Public Improvement Bonds to be used for constructing school buildings and additions to existing school buildings, remodeling existing school buildings, and acquiring necessary land and equipment; acquiring and improving lands for public parks, including playgrounds as a part thereof and constructing and equipping buildings and park improvements thereon; acquiring land, constructing structures and devices and performing operations to prevent flooding in the City of Alexandria; constructing sanitary sewers; paying the capital costs allocable to the City of Alexandria in the construction and acquisition of transit facilities in the Washington Metropolitan area by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority pursuant to the provisions of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Compact; constructing, paving, widening and otherwise improving streets, including bridges, viaducts and underpasses and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way; contributing funds for park purposes to The Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority, the members of which are the City of Alexandria, Arlington County, the City of Fairfax, Fairfax County and the City of Falls Church, and which was created to provide public parks and recreation areas located in, and to serve the inhabitants of, said political subdivisions; and constructing storm water sewers.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the sum of \$13,820,000 be and the same hereby is appropriated for the purposes of constructing school buildings and additions to existing school buildings, remodeling existing school buildings, and acquiring necessary land and equipment; acquiring and improving lands for public parks, including playgrounds as a part thereof and constructing and equipping buildings and park improvements thereon; acquiring land, constructing structures and devices and performing operations to prevent flooding in the City of Alexandria; constructing sanitary sewers; paying the capital costs allocable to the City of Alexandria in the constructing and acquisition of transit facilities in the Washington Metropolitan area by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority pursuant to the provisions of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Compact; constructing, paving, widening and otherwise improving streets, including bridges, viaducts and underpasses and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way; contributing funds for park purposes to The Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority, the members of which are the City of Alexandria, Arlington County, the City of Fairfax, Fairfax County and the City of Falls Church, and which was created to provide public parks and recreation areas located in, and to serve the inhabitants of, said political subdivisions; and constructing storm water sewers.

Section 2. That the said sum be and the same hereby is allotted

the following bond accounts of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, in the amounts listed and for the purposes stated:

- (1) The School Building Bond Account to be used for constructing school buildings and additions to existing school buildings, remodeling existing school buildings, and acquiring necessary land and equipment \$ 1,200,000
- (2) The Public Parks Bond Account to be used for acquiring and improving lands for public parks, including playgrounds as a part thereof and constructing and equipping buildings and park improvements thereon 550,000
- (3) The Flood Control Bond Account to be used for acquiring land, constructing structures and devices and performing operations to prevent flooding in the City of Alexandria . 1,500,000
- (4) The Sanitary Sewers Bond Account to be used for constructing sanitary sewers 2,535,000
- (5) The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Bond Account to be used for paying the capital costs allocable to the City of Alexandria in the construction and acquisition of transit facilities in the Washington Metropolitan area by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority pursuant to the provisions of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Compact 3,620,000
- (6) The Street Bond Account to be used for constructing, paving, widening and otherwise improving streets, including bridges, viaducts and underpasses and the acquisition of necessary land and rights of way 3,375,000
- (7) The Northern Virginia Regional Parks Bond Account to be used for contributing funds for park purposes to The Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority, the members of which are the City of Alexandria, Arlington County, the City of Fairfax, Fairfax County and the City of Falls Church, and which was created to provide public parks and recreation areas located in, and to serve the inhabitants of, said political subdivisions 300,000
- (8) The Storm Water Sewers Bond Account to be used for constructing storm water sewers 740,000

Section 3. That before any project calling for the expenditure of the funds appropriated and allotted above be started, such project must be approved by a majority vote of the council members present at any lawful meeting of the City Council of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 4. That before any funds appropriated and allotted above are expended, such expenditure must be approved by a majority vote of the council members present at any lawful meeting of the City Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

Section 5. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
