

AN ORDINANCE to amend subsection (a), Section 42-6, by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (15), subsection (a), Section 42-14, by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (12), subsection (a), Section 42-19, by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (7), all of Article III, and Section 42-25 by amending and reordaining the caption thereof and by the addition of a new subsection lettered (u) of Article IV, all of Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article III relates to USE, AREA, ETC., REGULATIONS GENERALLY, which Section 42-6 relates to R-20 RESIDENCE ZONE, which subsection (a) relates to USES PERMITTED, which new subsection (15) relates to BUS SHELTER; SPECIAL USE PERMIT, which Section 42-14 relates to RD RESIDENCE ZONE, which subsection (a) relates to USES PERMITTED, which new subsection (12) relates to BUS SHELTER; SPECIAL USE PERMIT, which Section 42-19 relates to C-O COMMERCIAL OFFICE ZONE, which subsection (a) relates to USES PERMITTED, which new subsection (7) relates to BUS SHELTER; SPECIAL USE PERMIT, which Article IV relates to ADDITIONAL USE, AREA, ETC., REGULATIONS, which Section 42-25 and caption thereof relate to USE OF SUBSTANDARD LOTS; VISION CLEARANCE AT CORNERS; LIMITATION ON GROUPS OF ROW HOUSES; SPECIAL USES IN SUBSEQUENT ZONES; ADDRESSES FOR LICENSE PURPOSES; UNIT OF LAND NOT HAVING FRONTAGE ON PUBLIC STREET; RESIDENTIAL CLUSTER DEVELOPMENT; RESIDENTIAL PORTIONS OF URBAN RENEWAL PROJECTS, and which new subsection (u) relates to FRONT YARD SETBACK FOR BUS SHELTERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a), Section 42-6, Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and it hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection (15) to read as follows:

(15) Bus shelter (permitted with special use permit as specified in sections 42-68 to 42-71 of this Code).

Section 2. That subsection (a), Section 42-14, Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and it hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection (12) to read as follows:

(12) Bus shelter (permitted with special use permit as specified in sections 42-68 to 42-71 of this Code).

Section 3. That subsection (a), Section 42-19, Article III, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and it hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection (7) to read as follows:

(7) Bus shelter (permitted with special use permit as specified in sections 42-68 to 42-71 of this Code).

Section 4. That the caption of Section 42-25, Article IV, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and it hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 42-25. Use of substandard lots; vision clearance at corners; limitation on groups of row houses; special uses in subsequent zones; addresses for license purposes; unit of land not having frontage on public street; residential cluster development; residential portions of urban renewal projects; front yard setback for bus shelters.

Section 5. That Section 42-25 of Article IV, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and it hereby is amended by the addition of a new subsection (u) to read as follows:

(u) The front yard requirements of sections 42-5 to 42-22.2 of this Code shall not apply to bus shelters for which a special use permit has been granted pursuant to section 42-68 to 42-71 of this Code.

Section 6. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
