

ORDINANCE NO. 2034

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the second paragraph of section 42-25.3, Article IV-A, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article IV-A relates to FLOOD PLAIN DISTRICTS, which section 42-25.3 relates to REGULAR FLOOD PLAIN DISTRICTS - ESTABLISHED and which second paragraph relates to BOUNDARIES OF EACH DISTRICT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the second paragraph of Section 42-25.3, Article IV-A, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

The boundaries of each district are shown on a map numbered "PW-FPM-71" dated December 28, 1971, as amended on June 10, 1975, signed by the director of the department of transportation and environmental services, the mayor and the chairman of the planning commission of the city, which map is on file in the office of the director of the department of planning and community development and which is hereby made a part of this article of the City Code and such map and all notations, references and other data shown thereon are by this reference made a part hereof as is fully described herein. A copy of said map shall also be kept on file in the office of the director of transportation and environmental services.

Section 2. Copies of any matter incorporated in this ordinance by reference, including but not limited to the map numbered "PW-FPM-71" dated December 28, 1971, as amended on June 10, 1975, may be examined in the city hall of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, at the community service office, room 104, the office of the city clerk in room 302, and the entrance hall on Market Square.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, and date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
