

ORDINANCE NO. 2042

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain the first sentence of Section 36-59 of Article XI, Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 36 relates to TAXATION, which Article XI relates to SERVICE CHARGE FOR CITY AMBULANCE SERVICE, which Section 36-59 relates to IMPOSITION; EXCEPTIONS and which first sentence relates to IMPOSITION OF SERVICE CHARGE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the first sentence of Section 36-59, Article XI, Chapter 36 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Except as hereinafter provided, there is hereby imposed a service charge of thirty-five dollars per call, plus fifty cents per mile each way for each mile or fraction thereof operated outside the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, on each person being transported by or receiving ambulance service from the rescue squad of the City of Alexandria Fire Department.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 1975.
