

ORDINANCE NO. 2064

AN ORDINANCE to amend Article IV of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-98.1; which new section 22-98.1 relates to PERMITTING VEHICLE TO REMAIN PARKED AFTER EXPIRATION OF TIME LIMIT DESIGNATED BY OFFICIAL SIGN, which Article IV relates to STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING GENERALLY, and which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Article IV of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 22-98.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 22-98.1. Permitting vehicle to remain parked after expiration of time limit designated by official sign.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle or any person in whose name a vehicle is registered to cause, allow, permit or suffer a vehicle to remain in a parking space beyond the time designated by an official sign for a vehicle lawfully to remain in that space.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
