

ORDINANCE NO. 2066

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 2-28.1 and Section 2-31, Division 2, Article I, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article I relates to CITY COUNCIL, which DIVISION 2 relates to RULES OF PROCEDURE, which Section 2-28.1 thereof relates to REGULAR MEETINGS FOR PUBLIC HEARINGS, and which Section 2-31 thereof relates to ORDER OF BUSINESS GENERALLY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 28.1, Division 2, Article I, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-28.1. Regular meetings for public hearings.

The city council shall, except during the months of July and August, hold regular meetings for public hearings on the Saturday following the second Tuesday in each month at 9:30 A.M.; provided, however, that when any such day shall fall on or within 3 days of a legal holiday, the meeting may be held on the Saturday preceding the fourth Tuesday of the month.

Section 2. That Section 2-31, Division 2, Article I, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 2-31. Order of business generally.

At every regular meeting of the city council, the order of business shall be as follows:

- (a) Invocation.
- (b) Calling the roll.
- (c) Reading and acting upon the minutes of the previous meeting. If the city clerk, at least two days before the meeting, shall transmit to each member of the city council at his business or residence address a copy of the minutes of such previous meeting for inspection, reading thereof before the city council assembled may on motion be dispensed with and such minutes so inspected may be acted upon.
- (d) Report of the city clerk.
- (e) Reports and recommendations of the city manager.
- (f) Consideration of and action upon the docket.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
