

ORDINANCE NO. 2072

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 20-15 of Article I, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 20 relates to LICENSES, which Article I relates to IN GENERAL, and which Section 20-15 relates to REFUNDS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 20-15 of Article I, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 20-15. Refunds.

There shall be no refunds of any license tax paid under the provisions of this chapter, except in the case of the discontinuance of a business the license tax for which was paid based upon an estimate of gross receipts or in the case of error on the part of a city officer or employee. A refund due to the discontinuance of a business begun during the current license year shall be equal to the difference between the license tax on the estimated gross receipts for the current license year and the license tax on the actual gross receipts for the period of time the business is conducted during the current license year, provided that the amount of license tax paid shall not be less than the minimum tax of \$30.00 prescribed by section 20-18.

Section. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1976.
