

ORDINANCE NO. 2075

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain sections 20-73, 20-74, 20-75, 20-77, 20-79, 20-80 and 20-81 of Article III of Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 20 relates to LICENSES, which Article III relates to NONREGULATORY LICENSES, which Section 20-73 relates to PROFESSIONAL OCCUPATIONS AND BUSINESSES, which Section 20-74 relates to PERSONAL SERVICES, which Section 20-75 relates to BUSINESS SERVICES AND OCCUPATIONS, which Section 20-77 relates to RETAIL MERCHANTS, which Section 20-79 relates to WHOLESALE MERCHANTS, which Section 20-80 relates to CONTRACTORS AND CONTRACTING, and which Section 20-81 relates to MANUFACTURERS, MILLS AND PROCESSORS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the list of professional occupations and businesses in Section 20-73, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

- Appraisers of antiques/fine arts.
- Career consultants.
- Decorating consultants.
- Financial consultants.
- Food testing laboratory.
- Podiatrists.
- Psychotherapists.
- Security systems consultants.
- Social workers.
- Research and development.

Section 2. That the list of personal services in Section 20-74, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following in subsection (B) alphabetically:

- Plant sitter.

Section 3. That the list of business services and occupations in Section 20-75, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting and deleting the following alphabetically:

Automobile buyer's service.	Language translators.
Booking agents.	Mobile truck-washing services.
Building maintenance services	Referral services.
Customizing vehicles.	Tour guides.
Employment agencies.	
Graphic arts.	
Job printers and printing shops [to be deleted]	

Section 4. That the list of retail merchants in Section 20-77, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

- Art galleries.
- Photographic prints and slides.
- Printing.

Section 5. That Section 20-77, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding a new last paragraph to read as follows:

Any person or organization who sponsors a show or sale of goods, wares, and merchandise at retail and not for resale shall obtain one license under this section for such show or sale, notwithstanding that more than one of the categories of business enumerated in this section will be conducted at such sale, and shall pay for the privilege of conducting such show or sale a license tax of \$30.00 and, upon the termination of such show or sale, \$0.35 per \$100.00 of the gross receipts of such show or sale in excess of \$8,570.00; provided that no such license shall be issued for a period longer than one year.

Section 6. That the list of wholesale merchants in Section 20-79, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

Alcoholic beverages.

Section 7. That the list of contractors and contracting in Section 20-80, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

Dry walling.

Section 8. That the list of manufacturers, mills and processors in Section 20-81, Article III, Chapter 20 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by inserting the following alphabetically:

Job printer or printing shop.
Film processors.

Section 9. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective January 1, 1976.
