

ORDINANCE NO. 2077

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 22-9 of Article I of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article I relates to IN GENERAL, and which Section 22-9 relates to ACCIDENT REPORTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 22-9, Article I, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 22-9. Accident reports.

The driver of any vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury or death to any person or in property damage to an apparent extend of two hundred fifty dollars or more shall, within five days after the accident, make a written report of such accident to the police department.

The police department shall make such reports available to any person involved or injured in the accident or his attorney or to any authorized representative of any insurance carrier reasonably anticipating exposure to civil liability as a consequence of the accident.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
