

ORDINANCE NO. 2191

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain Section 37-16 of Division 2 and Section 37-35 of Division 3, all of Article I, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 37 relates to TAXICABS AND OTHER VEHICLES FOR HIRE, which Article I relates to TAXICABS AND FOR-HIRE VEHICLES, which Division 2 relates to CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY and which Section 37-16 thereof relates to DURATION and which Division 3 relates to DRIVER'S PERMIT and which Section 37-35 thereof relates to EXPIRATION OF PERMIT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 37-16, Division 2, Article I, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 37-16. Duration.

Every certificate of public convenience and necessity issued under the provision of this article shall, unless sooner suspended or revoked, expire on the last day of the birth month next after issuance of the owner of the vehicle certified except that certificates of public convenience and necessity issued on vehicles owned by entities other than individuals shall expire on June Thirtieth, next after issuance.

If the issuance of a certificate occurs less than six months prior to the date of expiration set forth above, then the date of expiration when the vehicle is owned by an individual shall be the last day of the birth month of the next calendar year after issuance and when the vehicle is owned by an entity other than an individual shall be June thirtieth of the next calendar year after issuance.

Section 2. That Section 37-35, Division 3, Article I, Chapter 37 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

Sec. 37-35. Expiration of permit.

All drivers' permits issued under this article, except temporary drivers' permits issued pursuant to section 37-28 of this Code, shall expire on the last day of the birth month of the holder of the driver's permit, unless sooner suspended or revoked, except that any person holding a valid driver's permit on July 1, 1977, will be allowed to operate on such permit until the last day of his birth month for calendar year 1978.

If the issuance of a new driver's permit occurs less than six months prior to the last day of the birth month of the holder, the driver's permit will not expire until the last day of the birth month of the holder of the next calendar year after issuance.

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction

together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
