

ORDINANCE NO. 2241

AN ORDINANCE to amend subsection (a) of Section 42-63, Article IX, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new subsection numbered (9); which Chapter 42 relates to ZONING, which Article IX relates to SIGNS, which Section 42-63 relates to RESIDENCE ZONES which subsection (a) thereof relates to RESIDENCE ZONES IN GENERAL and which new subsection (9) thereof relates to BILLBOARDS ON THE INSIDE OF FENCING IN ENCLOSED BALL FIELDS LOCATED IN PUBLIC PARKS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (a) of Section 42-63, Article IX, Chapter 42 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection (9) to read as follows:

(9) Billboards on the inside of fencing in enclosed ball fields located in public parks, subject to a special use permit as specified in sections 42-68 to 42-71 of this Code, provided that no such billboards shall exceed eight feet in height above grade.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
