

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (15) of subsection (B) of Section 22A-4 of Chapter 22A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22A relates to NOISE CONTROL, which Section 22A-4 relates to NOISES PROHIBITED--ENUMERATION, which subsection (B) thereof relates to ENUMERATION OF PROHIBITED ACTS and which subsection (15) thereof relates to PILE DRIVERS, HAMMERS, ETC.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (15), subsection (B), Section 22A-4, Chapter 22A of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(15) Pile drivers, hammers, etc. The operation on Sunday or between the hours of six (6) P.M., or nine (9) P.M. in the case of the operation of power mowers, and seven (7) A. M. Monday through Friday or nine (9) A.M. Saturday of any pile driver, power shovel, pneumatic hammer, derrick, steam or electric hoist, power mowers, power and chain saws, and tractors, or other equipment the use of which is attended by loud or unusual noise unless adjudged in the public interest and as provided by section 22A-7 of this chapter. The operation on Sunday or between the hours of six (6) P.M. and seven (7) A.M. Monday through Friday or nine (9) A. M. Saturday and on the days designated in section 22A-5(A)(5)(a) of this chapter, of power equipment the use of which is attended by loud or unusual noise unless adjudged in the public interest and as provided by section 22A-7 of this chapter.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
