

AN ORDINANCE appropriating Antirecession Fiscal Assistance Funds granted to the city on July 11, 1978, by the Office of Revenue Sharing of the Department of the Treasury of the United States Government pursuant to Public Law 94-369, Title II, as amended, which funds are unencumbered and unappropriated.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the Council of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, does hereby appropriate to the several funds hereinafter named certain funds received pursuant to an Antirecession Fiscal Assistance Fund grant by the Office of Revenue Sharing of the Department of the Treasury of the United States Government, which funds have heretofore been unencumbered and unappropriated, as follows:

1. Fire Station Maintenance	\$11,000.00
2. Ramsay Recreation and Nature Center - Staffing	9,000.00
3. City Print Shop - Equipment	1,610.00
4. Parks Maintenance - Staffing	10,908.00
GRAND TOTAL	\$32,518.00

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
