

ORDINANCE NO. 2293

AN ORDINANCE to amend and reordain subsection (17a) of subsection (a), and to further amend the aforesaid subsection by adding thereto a new subsection (17.2) all of Section 22-152.6 of Article V-A of Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 22 relates to MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, which Article V-A relates to PAYMENT, CONTEST AND ENFORCEMENT OF PARKING CITATIONS, which Section 22-152.6 relates to PENALTIES FOR UNCONTESTED PARKING CITATIONS, which subsection (a) relates to TENDER OF PAYMENT WITHIN THIRTY DAYS, which subsection (17a) thereof relates to PARKING IN SPACES RESERVED FOR HANDICAPPED PERSONS and which new subsection (17.2) relates to PARKING IN PERMIT PARKING DISTRICTS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That subsection (17a), subsection (a), Section 22-152.6, Article V-A, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended and reordained to read as follows:

(17.1) Ten dollars (\$10.00) for a violation of Section 22-114.1, "Parking in spaces reserved for handicapped persons."

Section 2. That subsection (a), Section 22-152.6, Articles V-A, Chapter 22 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new subsection (17.2) to read as follows:

(17.2) Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for a violation of Section 22-121.14, "Parking in permit parking districts."

Section 3. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
