

ORDINANCE NO. 2296

AN ORDINANCE to amend Division 1 of Article IV of Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, by adding thereto a new section numbered 2-51.01; which Chapter 2 relates to ADMINISTRATION, which Article IV thereof relates to POLICE, which Division 1 thereof relates to SAME--GENERALLY and which new Section 2-51.01 thereof relates to OFF-DUTY EMPLOYMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS AND DEPUTY SHERIFFS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Division 1, Article IV, Chapter 2 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto a new section numbered 2-51.01 to read as follows:

Sec. 2-51.01. Off-duty employment of police officers and deputy sheriffs.

Police officers and deputy sheriffs of the City of Alexandria may engage in off-duty employment which may occasionally require the use of their police powers in the performance of such employment, subject to such reasonable rules and regulations concerning such employment as may be authorized by the city manager and the sheriff for their officers and deputies, respectively.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
