

ORDINANCE NO. 2348

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the City of Alexandria, the owner of property located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, bounded by South Saint Asaph, King and South Pitt Streets, and its successors in title, to maintain an encroachment for a Courthouse building in, under, upon and over the public alley extending from South Saint Asaph Street to South Pitt Street in the City of Alexandria, Virginia.

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria is the owner of property located in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, bounded by South Saint Asaph, King and South Pitt Streets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria is in the process of constructing a Courthouse building on the aforementioned property, the south wall of which will encroach on the public alley extending from South Saint Asaph Street to South Pitt Street approximately one (1) foot for the length of the alley; and

WHEREAS, The alley area is sufficiently wide for pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, the said encroachment has been approved by the Planning Commission of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, and it is determined that this encroachment is not detrimental to the public interest; therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That the City of Alexandria and its successors in title, be and they hereby are authorized to construct and maintain the above-described Courthouse building which will encroach on the public alley between South Saint Asaph Street and South Pitt Street to a depth of approximately one (1) foot for the length of the alley, until such encroachment is removed or destroyed.

Section 2. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
