

ORDINANCE NO. 2363

AN ORDINANCE to amend Chapter 23 by adding thereto new sections 23-24.1 and 23-24.2, and to repeal Sections 16-1 through 16-19, Article I, Chapter 16, all of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended; which Chapter 23 relates to OFFENSES--MISCELLANEOUS, which new Section 23-24.1 relates to THROWING, LEAVING, ETC., GARBAGE, DEAD ANIMALS, ETC., ON PRIVATE PREMISES, and which new Section 23-24.2 relates to THROWING, LEAVING, ETC., GARBAGE, MIXED REFUSE, DEAD ANIMALS, ETC., ON STREETS, ETC.; PERMITS FOR DEPOSIT OF BUILDING MATERIAL, which Chapter 16 relates to GARBAGE AND REFUSE, which Article I relates to IN GENERAL, which repealed Section 16-1 relates to DEFINITIONS, which repealed Section 16-2 relates to SUBSTANCES NOT COLLECTED BY CITY, which repealed Section 16-3 relates to SPECIFICATIONS FOR ASHES, MIXED REFUSE AND TRASH RECEPTACLES, which repealed Section 16-4 relates to PAPERS, MAGAZINES, ETC., which repealed Section 16-5 relates to MISCELLANEOUS CONTAINERS FOR TRASH OR COLD ASHES, which repealed Section 16-6 relates to DEFECTIVE RECEPTACLES; COLLECTION OF LOOSE REFUSE, ETC.; COVERS TO BE KEPT ON MIXED REFUSE RECEPTACLES, which repealed Section 16-7 relates to WHEN COLLECTORS NOT REQUIRED TO COLLECT; EFFECT OF FAILURE TO COLLECT, which repealed Section 16-8 relates to COLLECTION GENERALLY; CONFINEMENT OF ANIMALS, which repealed Section 16-9 relates to MIXING OF TRASH, GARBAGE AND ASHES IN RECEPTACLES; WRAPPING AND PLACING GARBAGE, which repealed Section 16-10 relates to USE OF CITY SANITARY LANDFILL OR DUMP FOR MATERIAL FROM OUTSIDE CITY, which repealed Section 16-11 relates to THROWING, LEAVING, ETC., GARBAGE, DEAD ANIMALS, ETC., ON PRIVATE PREMISES, which repealed Section 16-12 relates to THROWING, LEAVING, ETC., GARBAGE, MIXED REFUSE, DEAD ANIMALS, ETC., ON STREETS, ETC.; PERMIT FOR DEPOSIT OF BUILDING MATERIAL, which repealed Section 16-13 relates to VEHICLES TRANSPORTING TRASH OR GARBAGE TO BE COVERED, which repealed Section 16-14 relates to ACCUMULATIONS OF GARBAGE, TRASH, ASHES, MIXED REFUSE OR MISCELLANEOUS REFUSE, which repealed Section 16-15 relates to DUTIES OF OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS, which repealed Section 16-15.1 relates to REMOVAL OF ACCUMULATIONS BY CITY; BILLING AND COLLECTION OF CHARGES; UNPAID BILL A LIEN, which repealed Section 16-16 relates to RULES AND REGULATIONS, which repealed Section 16-17 relates to ENFORCEMENT OF ARTICLE, which repealed Section 16-18 relates to SANITARY LANDFILLS and which repealed Section 16-19 relates to PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF ARTICLE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF ALEXANDRIA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Chapter 23 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto new section numbered 23-24.1 and 23-24.2 to read as follows:

Sec. 23-24.1. Throwing, leaving, etc., garbage, dead animals, etc., on private premises.

Except as provided by chapter 32A of this Code, no person shall throw, cast, deposit, drop, scatter or leave, or cause to be thrown, cast, laid, deposited, scattered or left, in or upon any private lot or premises in the city any coal, dirt, mud, mixed refuse, trash, ashes, garbage, gravel, sand, sawdust, shavings, hay, straw, leaves, offal, vegetable matter of any kind, any dead animals or putrescible matter of any sort.

Sec. 23-24.2. Throwing, leaving, etc., garbage, mixed refuse, dead animals, etc., on streets, etc.; permit for deposit of building material.

Except as provided by chapter 32A of this Code, no person shall throw, cast, deposit, drop, scatter or leave, or cause to be thrown, cast, laid, deposited, scattered or left, in or upon any street, alley, sidewalk, parking or other public place in the city any coal, dirt, trash, mixed refuse, mud, ashes, garbage, gravel, sand, sawdust, shavings, hay, straw, clippings, offal, vegetable matter of any kind, any dead animals or putrescible matter of any kind or building material of any kind; provided, that leaves may be deposited in the streets from October first to December thirty-first of any calendar year, for collection by the city.

In cases where it is necessary to get building material to premises by depositing the same in some public place, a permit shall be obtained from the city manager and notice of such permit shall be given the police department.

Section 3. That Sections 16-1 through 16-19, Article I, Chapter 16 of The Code of the City of Alexandria, Virginia, 1963, as amended, be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 4. That the title of and an informal memorandum explaining this ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation published in the city not later than five days following its introduction together with a notice containing the time and place for a public hearing. The city clerk shall have the full text of this ordinance printed in sufficient numbers to supply copies to meet request. The city clerk shall note the date of introduction and first reading, the date of publication, the date of the public hearing, and the date of the second reading and final passage in the minutes of the meeting. This ordinance shall become effective the date of its final passage.
